

PAPER PLATE ROCKING BOATS



You will need:

- Paper plate
- Patterned paper (or decorate your own)
- Stick
- Crayons, colouring pencils, felt tips, stickers (whatever you can find!)
- Scissors
- Blob of blue/white tac
- Tape



1. Fold your paper plate in half - this will be the base of your boat.



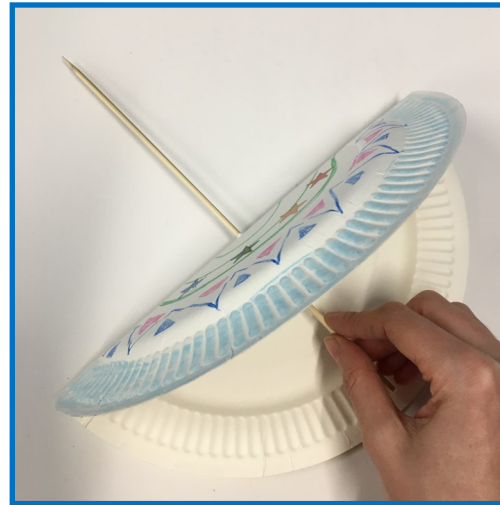
2. Decorate your paper plate. If you need inspiration look at the 'Patterns of Unbound' worksheet to see patterns from the exhibition.



3. Open your folded plate and use a pencil to make a small dot in the middle.



5. Get an adult to help you push the wooden stick until it goes through the plate and through to the other side.



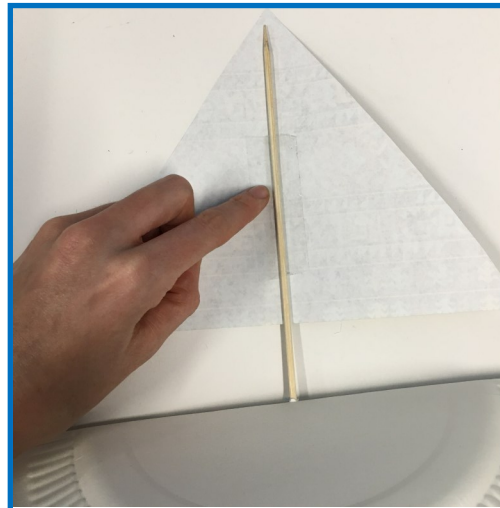
6. Continue pushing the stick through until most of it is sticking out the top.



7. Secure the stick inside the boat using a blob of blue tac. You now have a mast!



8. Choose the patterned paper you want to use for your sail. Then cut out your sail - you don't need a template for this - you can just freestyle.



9. Secure your sail to the mast using a piece of tape. Your boat is now ready to go!
