

STORY QUILT



You will need:

- Plain A3 paper
- Selection of fabric squares (we used 6x6cm squares for A3 quilt but it is not an exact science).
- Selection of colour paper for collage
- Colour crayons and/or pencils
- Glue stick
- Scissors



1. Pick fabric squares for the border of your story quilt. Try picking fabrics that represent you, for example your favourite colours or patterns.



2. Stick your fabric squares around the edge of your A3 paper to create a fabric 'quilt' border. If they don't fit you can layer them on top of each other or cut them a bit smaller.



3. Now its time to draw your story. Think about where you would like to fly over, and then use the crayons and colour pencils to draw it!



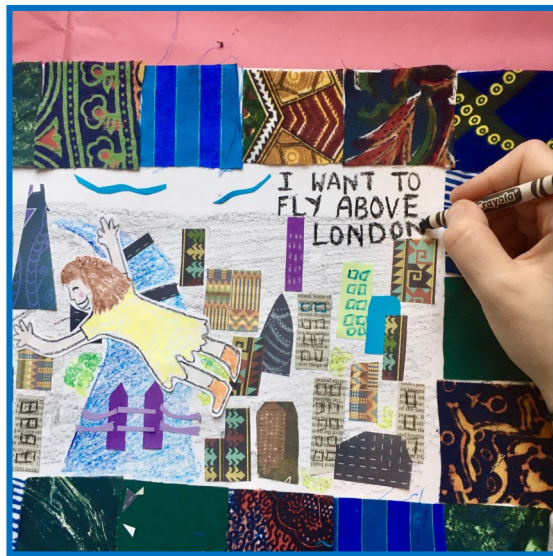
4. You can also cut and stick paper to decorate your story. Here I used different papers to create my buildings and houses.



5. Draw yourself flying on a separate piece of paper and colour it in.



6. Cut out your drawing of yourself and stick it onto your story quilt so that you are flying over your picture



7. Finally, write where you want to fly above – you now have your own story quilt.
