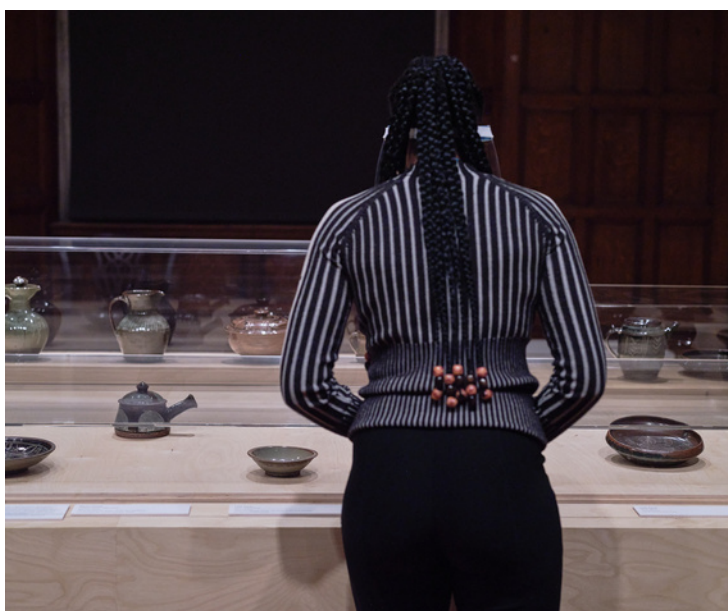

Two Temple Place is a unique architectural gem based in central London. It was built in 1895 for William Waldorf Astor, and features an eccentric array of interior crafts and décor. We are now recruiting Gallery Steward Volunteers to work with us in Spring 2023.

This is an exciting opportunity to join the Two Temple Place team and help us bring two new exhibitions to the public: *Inside*, created in partnership with Thorp Stavri, and *State-less 無國界*, created in partnership with Kakilang.



Our Gallery Steward Volunteers take on a vital public facing role that includes welcoming visitors at reception, supervising the exhibition spaces, answering visitor's questions and engaging them in the exhibitions, history, and craftsmanship of the building.



A team of more than 140 volunteers make a hugely significant and highly valued contribution to our exhibitions and events. Without them, we couldn't open our building for free to the public.

We welcome people of all abilities and offer a supportive environment for those with additional needs. We provide all training for the role. No prior volunteering or museum/gallery experience is needed, just enthusiasm and commitment!

- Using two-way radios (for building communications)
- Fire, and health & safety procedures
